Foundation Summer Term Curriculum letter

Hello and welcome to the Summer Term.

It is hard to believe that the children are now in their final term at school, how time flies! You will have recognised how settled the children are, how well they get on together and how happy and confident they all are.

We continue to have fun filled activities but work does start to be more structured this term, as we prepare for transition into Key Stage One. It is important that the children have as smooth a transition as possible, so we encourage them to sit and work at the tables and to try to become independent learners. I am really pleased with all of the children and their positive attitude towards this.

Every Friday afternoon the children work with Mrs. Rund on ICT skills, this ensures that they are familiar with the classroom and have built a relationship with Mrs. Rund before September. Transition for our children is usually a very smooth process. The children will spend two full mornings with Mrs. Rund and Mrs. Grundy in June when the new starters come in!
