### **Consent for taking the children to Church and on the Village walkways**

Over the course of the school academic year we take the children to church on the following occasions:-

- For whole school assemblies at least once each half term
- To practice the Christmas Carol Service, Nativity
- To practice for the Year 6 Leavers Assembly.
- To enrich the curriculum – e.g. when studying local history

Over the course of the year we may use the local pathways and puzzle wood to enrich the curriculum on occasions. For example:- when we are studying Geography or teaching the children orienteering.

Lancashire legal department has informed us that they highly recommend school now get written consent from parents to do this.

The recommendation is that parents' consent to their child being walked to church for the full year rather than consent for each and every time this happens, and also consents to using the local pathways and woodland for the whole year rather than individual consent.
