Literacy - we will continue to write sentences using punctuation. Some of the children are starting to work on writing short stories. The children practise their handwriting every day and we will continue to embed the diagraphs in phase 3 phonics.

Forest School will continue to take place on a Tuesday afternoon and PE will be on Wednesday. In PE we will be practicing our sports day races.

We will base much of our work this term on the Rainbow Fish, this is a lovely story about sharing and can be used for some wonderful creative work.

Reports will be sent home in July and children will be awarded a level of exceeding, expected or developing in 17 areas. We are focusing on any areas where we feel your child may need some extra help to gain the expected level. However, please do not feel that if they are awarded developing they have failed. This is definitely not the case, it just means that extra support will be in place next year. All of the children have worked extremely hard and made excellent progress at their level.

The children continue to spend Friday afternoon with Mrs Rund. This is a super way of ensuring that the transition to Class One is as smooth as it can be. With this in mind, mornings in the Foundation class will start to become more formal.
