Toilet facilities will be available for families although these may be staggered as only one school WC will be available. If you do need to use the toilet please press the buzzer outside the school office and wait outside. The office staff will direct you into the building to use the visitor toilet. Please note face masks must be worn when entering the building and hands sanitised.

It is anticipated that the assembly/picnic will finish around 11:30am, with the children returning to class until released at 1:15pm – in line with our staggered collection system. This will allow year 6, to say a final farewell to teachers and staff and of course get their school shirts signed by other children in their class bubble.

Please ensure your child has a spare, white shirt in their schoolbag on the day, for signing.

Please be aware that if there is a 'high chance of rain' forecast for the 16th July, arrangements may have to be made to bring the event forward, as the 16th is the last day of term. School will do its utmost to assess the likelihood of this and let you know, as soon as is possible.
