Uniform

As we prepare to embark on this new school year, I would like to request your continued support regarding our student uniform policy. The school uniform is a vital aspect of our identity and plays a significant role in fostering a sense of community and pride among our pupils. Additionally, it contributes to a focused, happy, and disciplined learning environment. We kindly ask that you ensure your child adheres to our uniform regulations as we begin in September.

School Bags

Due to limited cloakroom space, we must be mindful of the size and type of bags brought to school:

- **Infant Children (FS – Y2):** Students in the infant department are required to use a small red book bag. No other bags will be permitted. The children should only bring their reading books and diaries, which fit comfortably in the red book bag. Please ensure that these bags are clearly labelled with your child's name.
- **Junior Children (KS2):** The cloakroom area for junior students is also limited. Children in this phase should bring their reading books, pencil cases, and homework books to school each day. They may use either a small rucksack or a red book bag.

Homework

Homework timetables for each class will be posted on the classroom doors for your reference. To allow our students to adjust back into the school routine, we will adopt a lighter homework schedule for the first few weeks.

Stationery

In KS2, students are encouraged to bring their own pencil cases. We kindly ask that these are not oversized and can fit within the child's tray.

Extra-Curricular Activities
